

# ASD Evaluation & Consultation

## Description of Services

SERESC school based psychology consultants provide a comprehensive diagnostic evaluation for students suspected of having autism spectrum disorder (ASD) as well as evaluations to update their current learning and behavioral profiles as it relates to ASD. Various assessment tools are used to understand the student's social and behavioral functioning, including the Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule, 2nd (ADOS-2). Due to the range of presentations of individuals on the autism spectrum, practical recommendations are tailored to the student's strengths and areas of challenge. Each evaluation is conducted at the student's school to directly observe the student in their school environment. Additional developmental, cognitive, and academic achievement assessment is available to assist educational teams and parents in better understanding the student's profile.



## Consultation Services

Follow up consultation services are available to assist educational teams in implementing the recommendations offered through the evaluation. Functional Behavior Assessments (FBA) are available as well to provide specific analysis of behaviors to create a Behavior Intervention Plan (BIP).

## Areas of Evaluation

Evaluations are customized to meet specific referral questions. Potential areas of evaluation include social and behavioral skills, adaptive functioning, cognitive, neuropsychological, academic, and developmental functioning.

## Age Group

Services are available for school age students ages 3-21.

## Fees for Services

Fees are determined individually for each case. Service fees are dependent upon the specific evaluation and consultation services requested.
